In accordance with the Accountability of Tax Dollars Act of 2002, we are initiating an audit of the National Transportation Safety Board's (NTSB) financial statements for fiscal years 2017 and 2016. We have engaged an independent audit firm—Allmond & Company, LLC—to conduct this audit. The firm will conduct its work subject to OIG oversight and in accordance with generally accepted Government auditing standards and the Office of Management and Budget's (OMB) Bulletin 15-02, Audit Requirements for Federal Financial Statements.

Allmond expects to begin its work by mid-April, and conduct the audit at NTSB Headquarters in Washington, DC, and its service provider in Denver, CO. The audit report is due to OMB by November 15, 2017.
