She managed the legal work on the DOT Headquarters Project, which involved lease, construction, and contract management matters; provided advice on the Federal Aviation Administration's AAS Cost and Schedule Task Force and the Secretary's Safety Review Task Force; and served as the legal advisor to DOT's Investment Review Board for several years. She received the Secretary's Silver Award for Meritorious Achievement on Departmental Procurement Programs and several other Secretarial and General Counsel Awards for her advice regarding major system acquisitions and procurements throughout the Department.

Ms. Langan-Feirson received a B.A., with honors in political science from the University of Arizona in 1977 and a J.D., cum laude, from the University of Maryland in 1980. She is an active member of the DC Bar and also holds a master's certificate in government contract management from the George Washington School of Business.
